This workshop will bring together a variety of climate change professionals: educators, youth, civil society organizations, private sector representatives and **CONNECT4CLIMATE** partners. Together they will identify practical and useful strategies for igniting a more energetic, robust global movement to combat climate change.

In the morning you will discuss the challenges of building the climate movement, in the afternoon we will hear and discuss Pecha Kucha case studies, a panel discussion and high-profile sessions on HOW WE CAN BE THE MOVEMENT.



It was launched by the World Bank, the Italian Ministry of the Environment, and the Global Environment Facility in September 2011. It aims to amplify the voices of climate change knowledge brokers, solution drivers and action advocates. In two years Connect4Climate has built an active online community of more than half a million members from all over the world. With more than 160 members in the coalition Connect4Climate has developed an essential platform where people of all ages share experiences, ideas, images and solutions on climate change issues. Connect4Climate is a campaign, a coalition and a community that cares about climate change. Pecha Kucha is a presentation format in which each presentation is exactly 20 powerpoint slides long and each slide is shown for 20 seconds.
